- Effective January 1, 2015
- Required Domain-related (Group A) and optional Professional Development (Group B) CPEs will now be evenly divided across the three year cycle
- The total number of CPE hours required for each certification remains the same.
- Group B CPEs remain optional and may be substituted by Group A CPEs.
- CPE rollover credits are now limited to the total CPEs required for one year earned in previous six (6) months
- Rollover CPEs eligible to satisfy the annual CPE requirement for the first year of the next cycle
