For 10 of those years, he worked in the datacenter implementing many IT Security solutions and ultimately maturing business processes in order to substantiate a Security Operations Center. He then moved over to the CIO's office working directly for the CISO as a Director of Technical Operations where he led many governance initiatives including, but not limited to, Enterprise Penetration Testing Program, Data Loss Prevention Program, Static Code Analysis, Incident Response Process and Reporting, Trusted Internet Connections including Einstein 2 and 3 implementations, and implementing their CDM dashboard and reporting utilizing Splunk as the enterprise platform.

Tackling the Ever-changing Security Landscape

Cybersecurity is evolving to the point of needing a significant transformation in how cybersecurity processes are executed and managed. The transformation of thought will take time, but fortunately they should begin to focus around the business which allows the concept of “baked in security” to be realized. This presentation takes a strong focus as what technologies are available that organizations should consider to centralize data sources, consolidate IT infrastructure, become more cloud ready and also to allow cybersecurity professionals increased analytics and visibility. This enablement also allows the much needed position to become a stakeholder within every conversation, again allowing for “security by design” management of organizational assets including applications. It will be the only way to keep up with the threat by leveraging existing security tools, but by changing the way that we feed them intelligence by focusing on mission drivers that are not only cyber focused, but also performance focused and customer focused. I also touch on how this should be implemented in user training and building an adequate workforce for years to come.

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
