



Anne Cutter Keeper Security


Anne Cutler is a communications professional specializing in cybersecurity, with more than 15 years of industry experience and proven track record of growing brand awareness for organizations. Anne is the Director of Global Communications for Keeper Security, the leading provider of best-in-class password management, secrets management, privileged access, secure remote access and encrypted messaging. Anne leads public relations, cybersecurity research, analyst relations, social media, as well as all other internal and external communications for Keeper.

Prior to Keeper, Anne worked in government as the media strategist for the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and the Department of Homeland Security Science and Technology Directorate (DHS S&T). At CISA, Anne brought cybersecurity to the forefront of American consciousness through messaging and media engagement for the nation's lead cyber defense agency. Anne was the communications lead for CISA's Shields Up campaign- the agency's cybersecurity response to the war in Ukraine. She conducted crisis communications response for major cyber incidents including Colonial Pipeline, JBS, and Kaseya ransomware attacks, and Apache Log4j vulnerability.

Anne will explain the critical importance of communication in the ever-expanding field of cybersecurity with real-world examples, including the Shields Up campaign at the onset of the war in Ukraine and the unprecedented response to the Apache Log4J vulnerability.
