



He has battled spammers for decades and his research protects hundreds of millions of Internet users every day. In February 2025, he was awarded the Mary Litynski lifetime achievement award for keeping the internet safe from M3AAWG.org. KAM is a Center for Innovative Technology MACH37 Cyber Security Incubator Graduate and a member of the board of advisors for Virtru.com & SecurityUniversity.edu. He is also named a Distinguished Senior Fellow as a thought leader in the field of Cyber Security at Thomas University's Armed Services Institute in the Center for Military Life.

Emerging Leadership Challenges: 'Balancing Business as Usual' with Strategic Imperatives Given Emerging IT Workforce Shortages

A recent qualitative research project into the growing challenges which IT/IS teams face in balancing strategic priorities with urgent demands uncovered key gaps.

These gapes related to leadership effectiveness, change management, emotional intelligence, and the misalignment between implementation and actual adoption of new technology (e.g., AI, ML, manufacturing automation, etc.).

This presentation will address the escalating talent gaps which perpetuate IT/IS under-investment, how AI threatens to disrupt succession planning, and a 3-pronged approach to mitigate these challenges and help position IT/IS as a strategic business partner and not simply a cost center.
