Women: Bringing Diversity to Cybersecurity SANS CyberTalent

Overview:

- Partnership with the National Center For Women in Information Technology (NCWIT)
- 300 inquiries with 200 qualified candidates taking the Aptitude Exam
- 90 high scoring candidates identified and invited to submit resumes and transcripts; 35 final interviews
- 19 top candidates selected for the initial cohort. 16 have passed GSEC, 11 have passed GCIH, and 6 have achieved the third GIAC certification.

Curriculum:

- SEC401 was taken live at SANS conferences in Summer 2016
- SEC504 was taken OnDemand after passage of GSEC; third elective is offered OnDemand to successful candidates as well
- Expected graduation in February 2017

Employment:

- Graduates will be matched with prospective employers
- Five (5) cohort members have been hired as of January 1, 2017
